

## CASI announces JES<sup>2</sup>Mail / JES<sup>2</sup>FTP 5.1 - PDF Direct Print, AES hardware encryption and improved transport reliability headline latest release

**Fountain Valley, CA.** CASI Software, innovators in the development of IBM z/OS information transformation and delivery technologies, today announced the release of JES<sup>2</sup>Mail /JES<sup>2</sup>FTP version 5.1.

JES<sup>2</sup>Mail and JES<sup>2</sup>FTP transform JES and sequential file report content into PDF, XML, HTML and other formats; enhance the output with advanced PDF Overlays (forms), encryption and password-protection; and automatically deliver the results via email, to network servers, or using RSS web feeds. Release 5.1 is both a roll-up of all software maintenance since v5.0 and includes several significant product enhancements.

Major JES<sup>2</sup>Mail /JES<sup>2</sup>FTP 5.1 enhancements include: PDF Direct Print support; System z AES hardware encryption; and improved transport reliability.

The PDF Direct Print support allow one to utilize this feature, implemented in printer firmware, to send PDF files straight to a TCP-IP attached printer, without printing via an application or using a printer driver. This new capability may allow an organization to reduce or eliminate the need for expensive 3<sup>rd</sup> party z/OS print management software.

AES hardware encryption support uses configuration statements to instruct JES<sup>2</sup>Mail/JES<sup>2</sup>FTP to utilize native IBM System z cryptographic *hardware* for PDF compression and encryption to significantly reduce CPU processing cycles.

Improved transport reliability allows JES<sup>2</sup>Mail's built-in, highly efficient SMTP services to use an optional two-stage process using either IBM's CSSMTP or CASI's QMail facility.

JES<sup>2</sup>Mail/JES<sup>2</sup>FTP 5.1 is generally available March 1 to all current maintenance customers and can be downloaded directly from the CASI Software web site ([www.casisoft.com](http://www.casisoft.com)). CASI continues to offer free, no obligation trials of the full JES<sup>2</sup>Mail/JES<sup>2</sup>FTP product suite and provides proof-of-concept technical support during the trial period.
